<p>The visit to the Danube University Krems was organized within the activity 3.4 National competition for (BSc, MSc, PhD) best ideas of students.</p> <p>The purpose of the visit was the introduction of Serbian HEI's students (winners of local competition) to the practices of Danube Krems University in the area of entrepreneurship and innovation management, as well as start-up initiatives.</p> <p>During the first day, students had an opportunity to learn more about study programs at DUK with specialization in entrepreneurship and innovation management.</p> <p>After the presentation, a special session was organized for them as consultations with the project coordinator, Prof. Dr. Vesna Mandic and Act3.4 task leader from Business Incubator Novi Sad (BINS), Mr. Djordje Celic. The aim of these consultations was to present the ideas qualified for the National Competition and provide the feedback and guidelines on how to further improve the ideas and presented business models.</p> <p>On the second day, a visit to IMC Co-working Space was organized. The participants had an opportunity to find out about one of the mechanisms for support to the development of innovations and entrepreneurship, especially for students. They visited the space particularly oriented on provided the opportunities for networking, collaboration and cooperation.</p> <p>After the visit, a presentation of examples of good practice in start-up initiatives was presented by Doris Steinacher and Thomas Nennadal from Gründerservice. They presented the mechanisms and support they provide for the development of the innovations.</p> <p>In the second half of the day, based on everything they learned and heard, and particularly based on the inputs from the consultations from the previous day, students presented their improved and adjusted business models in terms of seven-minute pitch presentations. After each presentations, other participants provided their comments and feedback on the presented ideas.</p> <p>The second working day was successfully closed at 14:00.</p>
